Choir Visit to Guildford Cathedral on Saturday 22nd October

The choir are singing Choral Evensong at Guildford cathedral on 22nd October. The coach will leave from outside St Mary's at 0930, arriving at around 1200 at the cathedral. Choral Evensong will be sung at 1700, with the coach departing for home at 1800 and hopefully arriving in Bampton between 2000 and 2030. A 50 seater coach is being booked, and the spare seats after choir and their families have been catered for are available on a first come first served basis. There will have to be a charge for this (to be announced) to help defray costs. There is a good café in the cathedral; cathedral tours are available. The cathedral sits about 3 miles from the city centre, but there is a local bus route that runs from the bottom of the cathedral hill into the city centre.
